
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

The EAST BATON ROUGE PARISH Clerk of Court's office will be physically closed during this same time period, except that it will be open only for emergency filings between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
