**EMERGENCY ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the Governor of Louisiana in his Proclamation 75 JBE 2020 of June 4, 2020 did suspend all legal deadlines until at least June 15, 2020:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that filings otherwise due in this Court between March 12, 2020 and June 15, 2020 shall be considered timely if filed on or before June 16, 2020.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that parties who are unable to meet these deadlines due to the COVID-19 emergency may submit motions for extensions of time, supported by appropriate documentation and argument.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that these dates remain subject to change by Order of this Court; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that to the extent prior Orders of this Court conflict herewith, this Order supersedes all previous conflicting provisions and all provisions not in conflict herewith remain in effect.
