EMERGENCY ORDER

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1, the inherent power of this Court, and considering Act 162 of the 2020 Regular Legislative Session (signed by Governor John Bel Edwards on June 9, 2020) and the state and federal health guidelines associated with the coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all deadlines set by this Court in all cases pending before this Court are **HEREBY EXTENDED THROUGH JULY 5, 2020**. All filings due during the period of March 12, 2020 through July 5, 2020, or which become due during this period shall be deemed timely if filed on or before Monday, July 6, 2020.

Parties who are unable to file within this extended time may submit a Motion and Order with supporting documentation and argument requesting reconsideration of timeliness or other such relief.


