Emergency Closing Order

La. R.S. 1:55(E)2

Upon Oral Motion of the Clerk of Court and upon consideration of public health recommendations for the COVID-19 virus;

It is hereby ordered that the Vernon Parish Clerk of Court shall reduce its hours of operation due to the COVID-19 virus pandemic and to reduce risk of exposure to the public and the office staff during this health emergency. Any exposure would place staff at risk of getting the virus which would prevent our office from performing their duties and the public for conducting business with the Clerk of Court. This closure is considered a legal holiday under La.R.S. 1:55(E)2.

The Vernon Parish Clerk of Court is ordered to reduce their hours of operation to 8:00am to 1:00pm beginning March 23, 2020 and continue through April 9, 2020, subject to extension by order of the court.

If an emergency situation develops which, in the judgment of the clerk of court, renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the office of the clerk to continue in the performance of their official duties or for the general public to conduct business with the clerk's office, the clerk, with prior approval from the clerk's chief judge, may order the closing of his office for the duration of the hazardous or unsafe condition.

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
