
BROWN PELICAN

Adopted as Louisiana's State Bird July 27, 1966




MAGNOLIA

Adopted as Louisiana's State Flower August 1, 1900






CHIEF JUSTICE JOHN L. WEIMER

Chief Justice Weimer is the 26th and current Chief Justice of the Louisiana Supreme Court. There are seven Justices on the Court. He is Chief Justice because he has served the most years on the Louisiana Supreme Court bench among the seven Justices. When in court, the Chief Justice sits in the middle seat. Chief Justice Weimer was once a teacher of law and ethics at Nicholls State University and still visits schools to teach students about the law.



CHIEF JUSTICE PASCAL F. CALOGERO, JR. COURTHOUSE

Chief Justice Calogero served as the 23rd Chief Justice of the Louisiana Supreme Court and is the longest-serving Chief Justice in Louisiana's history. The Supreme Court building is named for him. He is credited with the renovation of and return to the Royal Street location in 2004. He retired from the Court in 2008.




CHIEF JUSTICE BERNETTE JOSHUA JOHNSON SUPREME COURT MUSEUM

Retired Chief Justice Johnson served as the 25th Chief Justice of the Louisiana Supreme Court. The museum in the front lobby is named for her. She is the first African American Chief Justice in the Court's history. She retired from the Court in 2020.


