
ORDER



ORDER

On motion of, and at the request of Clerks of Court Bridget Hanna (Ascension), Darlene Landry (Assumption) and Edmund Kinler (St. James) and upon representation to the Court, that to remain in conjunction with the offices of the Twenty-Third Judicial District Court, it is recommended that the offices of the Ascension, Assumption and St. James Parishes Clerks of Court close Friday, March 11, 2016 due to the threat of severe weather.

It is ordered, that, pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 1:55E(2), that the Offices of the Clerks of Court for the parishes of Ascension, Assumption and St. James be closed on Friday, March 11, 2016. The Ascension, Assumption and St. James Parishes Clerks of Court will reopen on Monday, March 14, 2016 for regular business hours. Further, pursuant to the provision of this section, the Clerks shall publish legal notice in the official parish journals advising of this closure and shall attach a statement advising of the action to every petition or pleading filed in each Clerk's Office on the first day or part of a date his/her office shall be reopened when such petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal, or other matters against which prescription could have run or time periods imposed by law could have expired.
