ORDER OF CLOSURE

PURSUANT to the provisions of R.S. 1:55, Ranord J. Darensburg, Judicial Administrator of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court has requested the closure of the offices of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court for the date of Wednesday, July 10, 2019 because of severe weather conditions in New Orleans and flooding inside areas of the building at Orleans Parish Juvenile Court. The weather conditions and flooding in the building pose unsafe conditions for employees of the Court to perform their duties or for the general public to conduct business with the Court. Under these circumstances and because of this situation, public access to Orleans Parish Juvenile Court will be hazardous.

Acting in accordance with LA. Const. Art. V., Subsection I and the inherent power of this Court, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

Because of weather conditions in the City of New Orleans, flooding inside areas of the building at Orleans Parish Juvenile Court, and the uncertainties of the extent of the impact the weather may have on the employees and public traveling to and from the building, the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court, Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana and the Orleans Parish Juvenile Clerk of Court's office shall be closed Wednesday, July 10, 2019 and will re-open Thursday, July 11, 2019 at 8:30a.m.

This closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.
