**ORDER OF CLOSURE**

**PURSUANT** to the provisions of R.S. 1:55, Ranord J. Darensburg, Judicial Administrator of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court has requested the closure of the offices of the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court for the date of Thursday, July 11, 2019 because of severe weather conditions in New Orleans area. The weather conditions pose unsafe conditions for employees of the Court to perform their duties or for the general public to conduct business with the Court. Under these circumstances and because of this situation, public access to Orleans Parish Juvenile Court will be hazardous.

Acting in accordance with LA. Const. Art. V., Subsection I and the inherent power of this Court, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

Because of weather conditions in New Orleans and uncertainties of the extent of the impact the weather may have on the employees and public traveling to and from the building, the Orleans Parish Juvenile Court, Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana and the Orleans Parish Juvenile Clerk of Court's office shall be closed Thursday, July 11, 2019 and will re-open Friday, July 12, 2019 at 8:30a.m.

This closure shall be considered a legal holiday in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.
