O R D E R

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, article V, section 1, and the inherent power of this court, and considering the hazardous conditions in Orleans parish and the surrounding areas associated with hurricane Ida:

IT IS ORDERED that the Court of Appeal, Fourth Circuit is closed and will remain closed until further notice. This emergency closure is put in place in consideration of safety and in consideration of impact to the infrastructure of the parish from the hurricane. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any matter with a filing deadline during this emergency closure shall have that filing deadline extended until three (3) days after the Court resumes normal operation;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall waive the convenience fee associated with the use of the Court's electronic filing system during the duration of this emergency closure;
