CALOGERO, C.J. DISSENTS AND ASSIGNS REASONS:

I dissent from the majority’s per curiam reversal and reinstatement of the district court’s granting of GrayStar’s motion for summary judgment at this stage of the proceedings and by this means. I am of the view that this action should not be taken summarily and simply upon GrayStar’s application for writs, but rather, if appropriate, only after granting the writ, entertaining oral argument, and rendering an opinion and judgment of the court. I would therefore simply grant the writ and docket for oral argument.
