erred in not directing that the matter be investigated further pursuant to Supreme

Rules 3.3(a)(1), 3.3(a)(3), and 3.8(d) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.
Accordingly, this matter is remanded to the Office of Disciplinary Counsel to
conduct further investigation pursuant to Supreme Court Rule XIX, § 11(B).
