WEIMER, C.J., dissenting.

I very respectfully dissent. I would reject the petition for consent discipline and allow this matter to proceed to a public hearing on the merits.

I respect the decision of my colleagues, who I know have thoroughly and carefully evaluated this matter, as has the Judiciary Commission, which is constitutionally established to investigate and make recommendations to the Supreme Court regarding judicial discipline. <u>See</u> La. Const. art. V, § 25.

Nevertheless, a public hearing affords citizens the opportunity to evaluate the actions of public servants and can reassure the public that their government functions effectively.
