Crichton, J., would reject consent discipline and assigns reasons.

I would reject this petition for consent discipline as too lenient under the facts and circumstances of this case. Given that respondent has now had been arrested twice for DWI, and combined with his failure to self-report at least one of these arrests to the ODC,¹ I would impose some period of actual suspension.
