### ORDER

The Office of Disciplinary Counsel ("ODC") is currently investigating allegations that respondent engaged in criminal conduct by driving under the influence, disturbing the peace while intoxicated, and battering a police officer. The ODC is also investigating allegations that respondent engaged in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice by failing to appear in court, following notice, for the purpose of addressing the pending criminal charges. Respondent now seeks to permanently resign from the practice of law in lieu of discipline. The ODC has concurred in respondent's petition.

Having considered the Petition for Permanent Resignation from the Practice of Law filed by Jennifer R. Treadway, Louisiana Bar Roll number 23333, and the concurrence thereto filed by the ODC,

IT IS ORDERED that the request of Jennifer R. Treadway for permanent resignation in lieu of discipline be and is hereby granted, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule XIX, § 20.1 and Rule 5.5 of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jennifer R. Treadway shall be permanently prohibited from practicing law in Louisiana or in any other jurisdiction in which she is admitted to the practice of law; shall be permanently prohibited from seeking readmission to the practice of law in this state or in any other jurisdiction in which she is admitted; and shall be permanently prohibited from seeking admission to the practice of law in any jurisdiction.
