**EXTENSION OF SUPPLEMENTAL EMERGENCY
PRO BONO CIVIL LEGAL ASSISTANCE RULE**

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the request of the Louisiana State Bar Association to continue in effect the Supplemental Emergency *Pro Bono* Civil Legal Assistance Rule approved by this Court on January 20, 2006, as amended on July 7, 2006,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

The Supplemental Emergency *Pro Bono* Civil Legal Assistance Rule, as amended, which permits non-admitted lawyers to provide limited *pro bono* civil legal services to victims of Hurricane Katrina and Hurricane Rita under restricted circumstances, be and is hereby continued in full force and effect for a period of one additional year. The Supplemental Emergency *Pro Bono* Civil Legal Assistance Rule, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect through January 19, 2008.
