considering the request of the Louisiana State Bar Association to continue in

effect the Supplemental Emergency Pro Bono Civil Legal Assistance Rule

approved by this Court on January 20, 2006, as amended on July 7, 2006,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

The Supplemental Emergency *Pro Bono* Civil Legal Assistance Rule, as

amended, which permits non-admitted lawyers to provide limited pro bono civil

legal services to victims of Hurricane Katrina and Hurricane Rita under restricted

circumstances, be and is hereby continued in full force and effect for a period of

one additional year. The Supplemental Emergency Pro Bono Civil Legal

Assistance Rule, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect through January

19, 2008.
