

SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

ORDER

Acting in accordance with Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the need to terminate the Temporary Emergency *Pro Bono* Criminal Legal Assistance Rule For Orleans Parish,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

The Temporary Emergency *Pro Bono* Criminal Legal Assistance Rule For Orleans Parish, which was signed on June 23, 2006, and the extension of that rule, which was signed on May 30, 2007, be and they are hereby terminated, effective at 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2007. Any and all criminal legal assistance and representation of clients by non-admitted lawyers pursuant to the Temporary Emergency *Pro Bono* Criminal Legal Assistance Rule For Orleans Parish shall cease as of the effective date and time of this termination Order.
